SIGNATURE EVENT

Lucknow Corporate Cricket League

The flagship championship, for pure corporate teams. Every player on the roster must work at the same company.

What is New in this Season:

1 A second trophy

The LCCL Champions League opens LCCL to squads built across more than one company, so a player without a full corporate side still has a season.

3 Awards decided on group stage

MVP, Orange Cap, Purple Cap and Best Fielder are judged on group games only, so every player is measured over the same number of matches.

2 A bigger field

Sixteen teams across both competitions, the largest field LCCL has fielded since Season 4.

4 Registration moves online

The whole entry process runs through **LCCL.IN** this season, from the team form through to payment.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The LCCL format is built for balanced competition and equal opportunity across the season. Group stage into knockouts, with a match structure refined across ten seasons.



Format Overview:

Stage 1 • Group Stage

Teams are divided into groups and play a round robin. Every side gets the same number of games.

Stage 2 • Knockout

Top-performing teams from each group advance to the eliminators and the finals of both trophies.

Playing XI	11 players per side
Squad Size	15 members
Match Duration	90 min at group stage
Ball	Soft Tennis Ball, Sixit ~80gm
New Ball	Each Innings
Total Teams	16 across both trophies

The structure, format, and match volume outlined above are tentative and based on current planning. Final details, including group composition, total matches, fixtures, and scheduling, will be confirmed only after the Captain's Meet, where all team captains will be invited to review the proposed format, share feedback, and raise clarifications. Following this discussion, the Organizing Committee will finalize and publish the official tournament schedule, which shall be deemed the binding version for LCCL Season 10.

*The Most Valuable Player, Orange Cap, Purple Cap and Yellow Cap are decided on **group stage statistics only**. Knockout matches do not count towards them. Every team plays the same number of group games, so every player is judged over the same sample and has an equal claim on these awards, however far their team goes.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

LCCL upholds the spirit of corporate cricket with integrity. Every player and team must meet the following standards to ensure fairness, safety and professionalism across the tournament.

Player Eligibility

AGE	25 or older
RESIDENCE	Permanent residents of Lucknow or Barabanki
EMPLOYMENT	Actively employed professionals at the time of registration, with proof
COMPETITIVE BACKGROUND	State or board level: eligible only if inactive 10Y A- division: 5Y B-division: 3Y C and D division: no restriction
GENERAL FITNESS	Every player must be physically fit for competitive sport. Players aged 50 and above need to submit a medical fitness certificate

Player Eligibility

LCCL	One company per team, every player from the same organisation
LCCL CHAMPIONS LEAGUE	Mixed squads, any combination of companies
SQUAD	15 members, 11 on the field
ROSTER FINALISATION	Rosters lock once approved. Replacements only for a medically verified injury
CAPTAIN'S RESPONSIBILITY	The captain is the single point of contact for communication, documents and compliance
LIABILITY	Every player signs a Declaration for Waiver and Release of Liability before taking the field

WHO WE DO NOT CONSIDER A CORPORATE EMPLOYEE

Advocates, police and security personnel, proprietorship firms, freelance workers, contractors, and suppliers or vendors of an organisation are not considered as corporate employees.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

Submitted per player, with the team roster, before the registration deadline.

AGE PROOF — ANY TWO

- High school marksheet
- PAN card
- Passport

*The date of birth must match across both documents.
No other document is accepted for age verification.*

RESIDENCE PROOF — ANY TWO

- Passport showing local permanent address.
- Electricity, water or gas bill, not older than three months.
- Registered or e-stamped rent agreement.
- Bank passbook or statement showing local address.

EMPLOYMENT VERIFICATION

- Current, valid company ID card
- Latest three salary slips, or an HR verification letter
- Bank statement showing corresponding salary credits

Mandatory for every player. Documents must clearly show full name, organisation and current employment status.

MEDICAL FITNESS

- Players aged 50 and above: a medical fitness certificate on the letterhead of a registered practitioner.
- Players with known medical conditions: a physician's clearance certificate

CAPTAIN'S PRE-APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Decide which competition you are entering, LCCL or LCCL Champions League.
- Confirm all 15 squad members meet the age, residence and employment criteria.
- Collect two age proofs per player, dates of birth matching.
- Collect two residence proofs per player.
- Collect employment verification per player.
- Arrange medical fitness certificates for any player aged 50 or above.
- Plan jerseys with player name and number, plus footwear and protective gear.
- Treat the roster as final once approved.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

EVERYTHING HAPPENS ON LCCL.IN

- Season 11 registration runs entirely through the LCCL website.
- Complete the team registration form, upload your documents, and a payment link is generated for you to settle online.

Player Eligibility

01

Registration

From 10 September, complete the team registration form on LCCL Website with your squad and player details.

02

Document Submission

Upload age, residence and employment proof for every player in the squad.

03

Payment

A payment link is generated once your form is submitted. Settle the participation fee online.

04

Verification

The organising committee reviews the roster and the submitted documents.

05

Confirmation

Once verified, your team receives official entry confirmation for Season 11.

06

Captain's Meet

Every captain is invited in person to review the format, groups and fixtures before the schedule is finalised.

WHAT THE FEE COVERS

- Ground booking and pitch preparation
- Certified umpires, scorers and match-day staff
- Live CricHeroes scoring and published scorecards
- Match photography
- Team intros and post-match award presentations
- Trophies and certificates

WHAT TEAM COVERS

- Jerseys, top and bottom, with player name and number
- Appropriate sports shoes or spikes
- Personal protective gear

KEY DATES

- Registration opens **1 Sep 2026**
- Registration closes **30 Sep 2026**
- Season starts **1 Nov 2026**

Returning teams keep first claim on their slots. Slots fill fast, register early to book your's.

RULES & CODE OF CONDUCT

GAMEPLAY & CONDUCT

- Matches begin strictly as per the published schedule. Late arrival may lead to overs reduction or forfeiture.
- Umpire decisions are final and binding
- Only registered players from approved squads may take the field.
- Zero tolerance for verbal abuse, physical aggression, sledging or any unsporting act.
- Alcohol, tobacco and intoxicants are prohibited before and during matches.
- Captains are accountable for the conduct of their team

GAMEPLAY & CONDUCT

- Umpires and match referees may issue warnings, penalty runs or suspensions.
- Aggression, threats or deliberate misconduct will lead to match bans or expulsion.
- Any attempt to manipulate results or forge documents means immediate disqualification.
- The organizers may modify rules, reschedule or relocate matches in response to weather, ground availability or administrative constraints.
- All rulings by the organizing body are final and non-contestable.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK & LIABILITY

- Cricket carries inherent risk of injury, dehydration, heat exhaustion and other health events. Participation is voluntary and at the player's own risk
- Mavex Sports, the organising committee, venue authorities and affiliates are not liable for injury, illness, accident, loss or damage arising in connection with the tournament
- Players are responsible for their own equipment, valuables and belongings
- First-aid and basic medical assistance is available at venues for immediate response. It is not a substitute for professional medical care
- Players with a history of cardiac disease or moderate to severe asthma are not eligible. Where there is medical uncertainty, a physician's clearance is required

Media rights and acceptance of terms.

By participating, players, teams and organisations grant Mavex Sports and its authorized partners the right to capture and use photographs, video, match footage and related content for promotion and documentation. All LCCL names, logos and brand marks remain the exclusive property of Mavex Sports. Registering a team implies full acceptance of the eligibility framework, code of conduct and tournament policies. Any dispute is referred first to the LCCL Disciplinary Committee, and failing resolution, to the exclusive jurisdiction of Lucknow courts.
